## Application for Admission 2017-2018

1. Complete an Admissions Application and submit it with a \$20.00 non-refundable fee made out to Great Bay Community College, or complete an online application at [www.greatbay.edu](http://www.greatbay.edu).
2. Request an official copy of your high school transcript or GED equivalency scores to be sent to the Admissions Office. If home schooled, please contact the Admissions office to speak to an admissions counselor. **Please note:** Ask your high school to include your current name (if different from high school) on the transcript as this will allow us to process your application more quickly. Current High School Seniors admitted to Great Bay Community College must request that their final transcripts indicating a graduation date and successful completion of all requirements for high school graduation be forwarded to the College.
3. If you are applying to one of the following programs of study, please complete the following:
  - **Medical Office Administrative Assistant:** Complete the Accuplacer Test as part of the Admissions process.
  - **Nursing:** Sign up to attend a Nursing Info Session to learn about the application process. Dates are available at [www.greatbay.edu](http://www.greatbay.edu). **Application Deadline is February 28<sup>th</sup>.**
  - **Surgical Technology:** Complete the Accuplacer Test as part of the Admissions process. **Application Deadline is April 1<sup>st</sup>.**
  - **Veterinary Technology:** Complete the Accuplacer Testing as part of the Admissions process. **Application Deadline is April 30<sup>th</sup>.**
4. If you want to be considered for Financial Aid, complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. You may file online at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov). Our school code is **002583**.
5. If you have earned prior college credit, please forward an official college transcript to the Registrars Office for transfer credit evaluation to be completed after acceptance into a program. If you wish to have an unofficial transfer credit evaluation complete prior to being accepted into a program, please complete the Unofficial Transfer Credit Evaluation Form and submit with college transcripts to the Registrars Office. Please allow a minimum of two weeks for processing.
6. Veterans must submit their DD214, Certificate of Eligibility for VA Education Benefits, and any other documentation required for GBCC to certify enrollment with the Department of Veterans Affairs.
7. Plan to take the Accuplacer placement test through the Center for Academic Planning and Support (CAPS). A \$20 non-refundable fee is required to take the Accuplacer. (Fee is subject to change). Placement testing can be scheduled through our website at <http://greatbay.edu/onlineappointment>
8. Attend an Advising appointment to pick your course schedule and complete your registration at our One Stop.
9. Attend New Student Orientation (date and time will be mailed) and begin classes! Familiarize yourself with Great Bay Community College by visiting our website at [www.greatbay.edu](http://www.greatbay.edu) and find us on [Facebook!](#)
10. **International Applicants are required to submit a non-refundable \$100 International Student Admissions Fee in addition to the application fee.** All application materials must be received at least 30 days prior to the start of the applied term.
