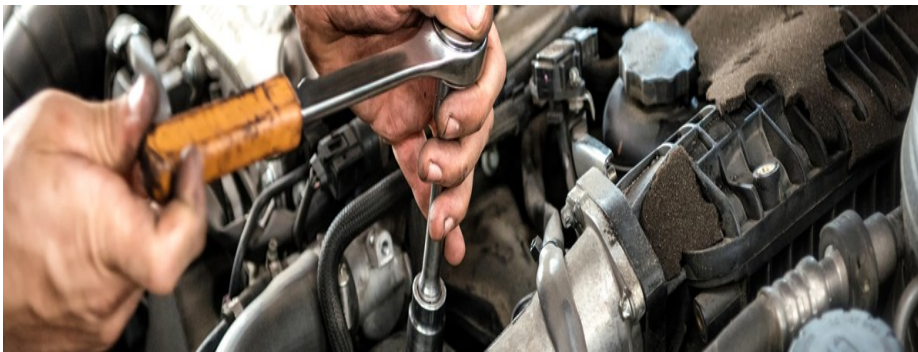


AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY

Certificate

The Automotive Technology Certificate provides students with skills and knowledge required for entry-level technicians performing inspection, diagnostics, maintenance and repair on automobiles and light trucks. Students will use investigative skills as they learn to locate problems, use a variety of power tools as well as hand tools and diagnostic tools as they work on parts, and work with technical reference materials. Applied math and computer skills will be incorporated throughout the curriculum. Completion of the certificate will prepare students for Student Certification ASE exams in some areas and entry level employment in the field.

The Automotive Technology program begins in the fall semester only. The Certificate is offered in the evenings and can be completed in three semesters.



Admissions Criteria:

- Complete an application to the certificate
- Provide official copy of High School completion or equivalent (GED/HiSet Scores)
- Applicants must possess and provide a valid drivers license
