

Non-Traditional Student Scholarship

**A nontraditional career is defined as one where less than 25% of the workforce is of your gender.*

What is the Non-Traditional Student Scholarship?

This scholarship is funded by the Perkins Grant, and is intended to recognize outstanding GBCC students for excelling in academic programs that are non-traditional to their gender.

Who is eligible to apply?

- Students must be matriculated (enrolled in a program).
- Students must be attending GBCC at the time of application.
- Students must have completed a minimum of six credit hours at GBCC.
- Scholarships are available to male and female students currently enrolled in programs non-traditional to their gender.
- Male students must be enrolled in: Early Childhood Education, Massage Therapy, Nursing, Surgical Technology, Veterinary Technology, or MOAA.
- Female students must be enrolled in: ACM, ACFAM, Computer Technologies, Criminal Justice, Homeland Security, Information Systems Technology, Management, and Welding.
- Student must be in good academic standing.

When should I apply?

Scholarships are awarded twice per year.

Deadline for Fall Award: September 21st

Deadline for Spring Award: January 31st

How do I apply?

- Applications can be picked up at the CAPS desk beginning in September for the fall award and January for the spring award **or** downloaded from the GBCC website
